### Hamilton Community Preservation Committee Public Hearing

On Tuesday, May 24<sup>th</sup> at 7 PM at the Hamilton-Wenham Public Library, the Hamilton Community Preservation Committee (CPC) will host a public hearing to obtain community input regarding future grants. The hearing will give community members an opportunity to comment on the town's needs, possibilities, and resources regarding historic preservation, community housing, open space and recreation. The CPC hopes to hear from residents at the hearing, but is also accepting written comments online (<http://www.surveymoz.com/s3/2738902/Town-of-Hamilton-CPC-Survey-2016>) and at the Town Clerk's office until June 3<sup>rd</sup>.

In May 2005, Hamilton voters adopted the Community Preservation Act (CPA), thereby establishing a fund dedicated to historic preservation, community housing, open space and recreation initiatives. Since then, more than forty projects have been successfully implemented. The CPC looks forward to input from community members to guide the future allocations of CPA funds.

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
