## PRESS RELEASE

The Hamilton Police Department is pleased to announce the commencement of its fourth Citizens Police Academy. The Academy will run from 6:30 pm to 9:00 pm for ten consecutive Tuesday's beginning on Tuesday September 23, 2014 and concluding on Tuesday November 25, 2014.

The Citizen Police Academy is designed to familiarize citizens with the operation and functions of the Hamilton Police Department, Communications Center and Fire Department. Classes will cover various topics such as Criminal Law, Patrol Procedures, Evidence collection, Domestic Violence, Motor Vehicle Enforcement, Court Procedures, and Use of Force. Additionally participants will be required to complete a 2 hour police ride along and a tour of the Middleton jail. The ride along will allow each student to observe Police Officers while on patrol. Courses will be taught by a Hamilton Police Officers, Police Supervisors, Hamilton Fire-fighters and Dispatch personnel.

There is no charge to attend, however, you must be 18 years or older. The class is limited to 20 applicants. Applications may be picked up at the Hamilton Police Department, 265 Bay Road or at the Town Clerks office, 577 Bay Road.
