

League of Women Voters Sponsors a Forum on Ballot Issues

A forum to explain and discuss two State Ballot questions and two local warrant articles will be sponsored by the Hamilton-Wenham League of Women Voters on Wednesday, October 3, 7:00 p.m. at the Buker School. The League, aware that voters will need to know about these issues before National elections (November 6) and both towns' fall meetings (Hamilton, Oct. 13, Wenham Oct. 27) has invited State and local representatives to explain their positions on the issues. There will be time for discussion.

Speaking in favor of Question 2, *Prescribing Medication to End Life* on the State Ballot will be Dr. Paul Spears, a representative from "Yes On Dignity." The speaker against will come from "The Committee Against Physician Assisted Suicide." (name coming 9/25)

The State Ballot's Question 3 has to do with *Medical Use of Marijuana.* Speaking for it will be a rep from "Committee for Compassionate Medicine." And speaking against it will be Dr. Jay Broadhurst from "Vote no on Question 3."

The last hour will be devoted to an explanation of the School Committee's capital request from the two towns for a \$2 million debt exclusion. It is being presented in two articles because one project requires separate financing.

The League also reminds residents that the deadline to register to vote in the November 6 elections is October 17.
