The Board of Selectmen met at Hamilton Town Hall at 9:01 a.m. on Thursday, October 7, 2010 with William Bowler, Jennifer Scuteri, Jeff Stinson and Marc Johnson present. Finance Director Deborah Nippes-Mena also present.

**Amend Ballot Language for Senior Tax Exemption**

Discussion on amended ballot language for senior tax exemption referendum question for election to be held Tuesday, November 9, 2010. Town officials wanted to ensure that the eligible household income range for applicants' language in the referendum question was as clear as possible to voters and legally accurate.

Jennifer Scuteri entertained a motion to change the language in a sentence Selectmen were discussing in the proposed ballot question to read "To qualify, the property must be the principal residence of the taxpayer, total annual household income shall not exceed the range of \$33,000 to \$49,499 for single applicants or \$49,500 to \$74,250 for married applicants, at least one owner/resident must be at least 65 or 70, as set annually by the Board of Selectmen" ...

Jeff Stinson so moved. Marc Johnson seconded the motion. VOTE: 3 in favor. William Bowler abstained.

Scuteri entertained a motion at 9:17 a.m. to adjourn. Bowler so moved. Johnson seconded the motion. VOTE: Unanimous.
