Project Description: This project provides additional funding to complete the renovation the remaining kitchenettes in Hamilton Housing Authority (HHA) apartments. Hamilton's HHA provides housing to 40 residents who are in need of affordable and elderly housing. Unfortunately, when the units were originally constructed in the 1960's the kitchenettes were not built properly and many of the residents struggle to reach the kitchen cabinets which were positioned significantly higher than what is deemed appropriate for standard kitchen design. Residents must now use step-ladders to reach the upper cabinets causing a safety hazard, especially for the senior residents.

Project:Restoration of the windows at the Old LibraryApplicant:Town of HamiltonCPA Purpose:Historic Preservation

Amount: \$7.500

Project Description: Originally constructed in 1960 as a public library, the building has been used, in part, as Hamilton's Senior Center since 2001 when the new joint Hamilton-Wenham Library was constructed. A recently completed study detailed improvements needed to adequately maintain the building. Renovation of the windows was one of the recommendations of the study. Presently, the windows do not open and close properly, are not properly sealed and cause significant heat loss. Renovation of the windows will provide significant energy savings and provide significantly improved ventilation in the warmer months thus allowing for expanded year-round use of this building by seniors, public safety personnel and community groups that meet there.
