On which **General Bids** are to be received until **2:00 P.M.**, **Wednesday**, **May 31**, **2017**. This Addendum forms part of the Contract Documents and modifies the original specifications and drawings dated April 2017. Acknowledge receipt of this Addendum in the space provided on the Bid Form. Failure to do so may subject the bidder to disqualification.

The following changes and/or additions are to be made to the Contract Documents:

Specifications

1. Section 00330 - Bid

• A.2 DECLARATIONS delete section and replace with the following:

A.2 DECLARATIONS

The BIDDER declares that no person in the employ of the OWNER is pecuniarily interested in this proposal or in the Contract for the work which he proposes to do, that he has carefully examined the Contract and Specifications and has informed himself fully in regard to all conditions pertaining to the site where the Work is to be done and has carefully estimated the work. He understands that the OWNER, its agents and employees, are not to be in any manner held responsible for the accuracy of, or bound by, any estimates or plans or locations of underground structures relating to the Work, and that if any have been given or made, they are to be considered solely as a base for filling out and comparing the several proposals.

The BIDDER proposes to furnish all the labor, equipment and materials required for carrying out the work in accordance with the accompanying Specifications and Drawings prepared by Stantec for the sums specified herein, subject to additions and deductions according to the Specifications, and in all respects according to the terms thereof.

BIDDER hereby agrees to commence Work under this Contract on or before the date to be specified in the Notice to Proceed and to substantially fully complete the work within <u>380</u> CALENDAR DAYS thereafter. The work shall be substantially completed in **290** days and final restoration in **380** days. Winter shutdown is anticipated, but the Owner, at its discretion may allow work to continue based on weather conditions. Final pavement will be 90 days after 4" trench binder pavement. BIDDER further agrees to pay as liquidated damages, the sum of **\$1,200** for each consecutive calendar day thereafter.

The BIDDER proposes and agrees that within 5 days next after the day on which Notice of the Award shall be given to him or mailed to him at the address hereinafter given, he will sign in quintuplicate agreements of the form provided in Section 00531, and will execute and deliver to the OWNER, Bonds in the sums specified, conditioned to faithfully furnish and do everything required of the CONTRACTOR, with a surety company authorized to do business in Massachusetts.

Bidder agrees to furnish and deliver all necessary materials and do all the work described in the specifications, for the following unit bid prices:

In case of discrepancy between words and figures, the amount shown in words shall govern.

- Q1-1 The specifications for the hydrants note that the hydrants shall be Waterous Pacer or approved equal. Can you advise what other hydrants are considered an approved equal?
