There is hereby established the Hamilton Open Space Committee, by the Board of Selectmen, on August 13, 2018

Purpose:

The primary purpose of the Open Space Committee is to maintain and update the Town's Open Space and Recreation plan, in accordance with the **OPEN SPACE AND RECREATION PLANNER'S WORKBOOK**, <https://www.mass.gov/files/documents/2016/08/tx/osrp-workbook08.pdf>

Representatives to the Open Space Committee:

The membership shall be representative of the population in Hamilton and to that end should include the following representatives:

- Conservation Commission member;
- Planning Board member;
- Recreation Director or Commission member;
- Historical Commission or Society member;
- member of Board of Public Health, Water Commission, or Public Works Department;
- Community Preservation Committee member;
- landowners;
- real estate, development, or business interests;
- citizens interested in community character and landscape preservation;
- citizens interested in the environment and natural resource conservation;
- citizens interested in playgrounds and recreation;
- citizens interested in trail development and use;
- citizens interested in rare and endangered species; and
- others determined by the Board of Selectmen to be important.
