

## RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE USE OF PATTON PARK

The Town property known as Patton Park and located on Bay Road and Asbury Street, including tennis courts, basketball court, parking areas and playing fields was established and is maintained as a recreational area by the Town. The Board of Selectmen for the Town of Hamilton, by virtue of its authority to make rules for the use and government of the Park of said Town, and for breaches of such rules to affix penalties, hereby ordains that within the limits of Patton Park, except with the prior written consent of the Board or its designee, as outlined below, it is forbidden:

This park is available for company, business, family picnics, and outings. A fee of \$50.00 has been established for up to 125 people. Over 125 people, a fee of \$100.00 will be charged and a police officer must be hired.

Permits must be signed and returned to the Hamilton Wenham Recreation Department with a copy to the police department and shall contain the following information:

- 1. Estimate number of guests.
- 2. Phone number of partied in charge of function.
- 3. A statement that releases the Town from any liability
- 4. The hours of the function
- 5. Description of the function held.

## PARK RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Park closed sunset to sunrise unless prior arrangements have been made with the Recreation Department to use the park lights.
- 2. Respect all Park buildings, swimming pool, playing fields, and pond
- 3. Park only in designated parking areas.
- 4. No alcoholic beverages, marijuana, or illegal substances
- 5. No religious or political rallies
- 6. No conduct giving cause for alarm or otherwise disorderly
- 7. No use of profane or obscene language
- 8. No recreational vehicles
- 9. Park must be left in condition it was found
- 10. All posted rules will be enforced
