The successful bidder must furnish a labor and materials payment bond in an amount equal to 50 percent of the total contract price.

All bidders must supply the Town with an insurance certificate and workmen's compensation policy, if applicable.

All crew members must be OSHA 10 certified.

All bidders must abide by all contract terms associated with the attached contract.

All bidders must sign FORM OF GENERAL BID, Attachment C, and Attachment D.
