FLOW TESTS

Flow tests performed in the Town of Hamilton must be approved by the Director of the Water Department/Department of Public Works.

Companies performing flow tests in the Town of Hamilton must have notification published in one of the local newspapers at least three (3) days prior to your flow test. The Hamilton Water Department must first approve and then be informed as to when your notification will be published at 978-468-5581. You will be invoiced for this Department's time (Minimum of 4 hours overtime/2 men) to open the hydrant and oversee your flow test. In addition, you must directly pay the newspaper for the cost of the publication in notifying residents of your flow test.
