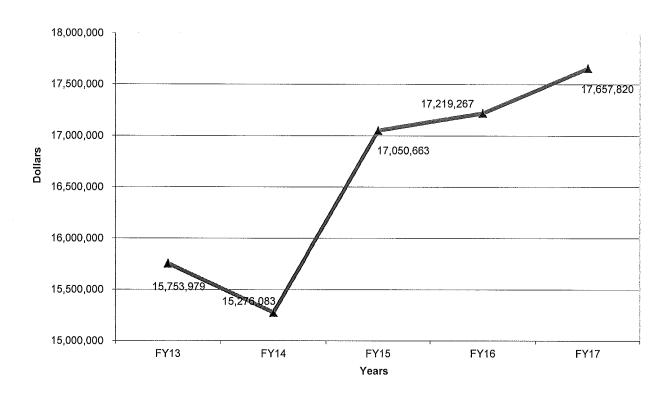

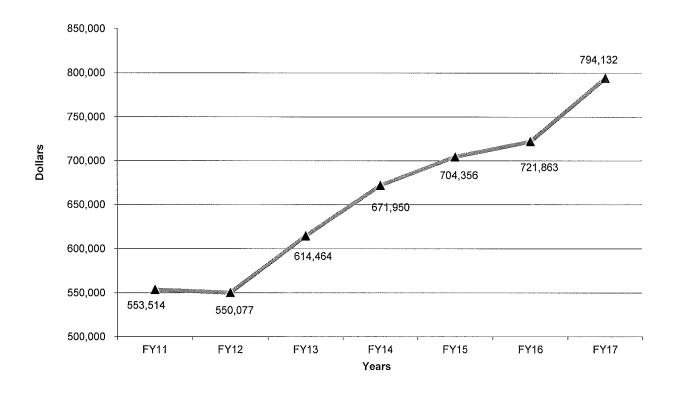
Education Costs

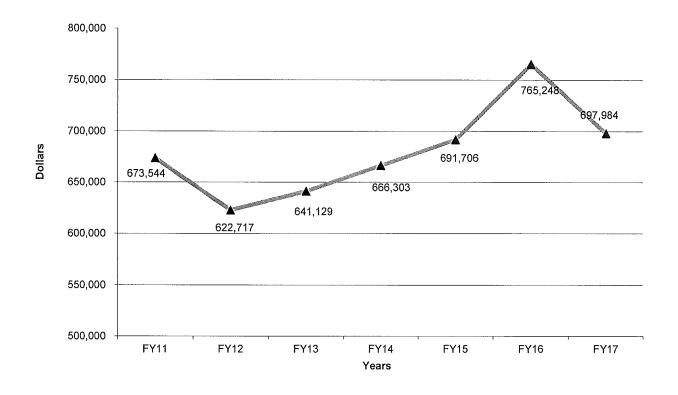
Retirement Costs

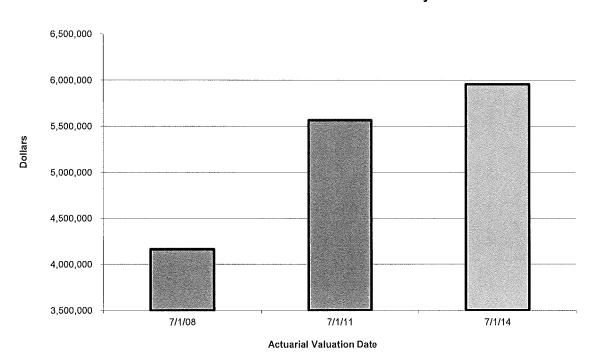
