

Hamilton Board of Health is Seeking a Member

The Town of Hamilton is seeking to fill a board member vacancy on the Board of Health. The Board of Health consists of three members appointed by the Board of Selectmen. Each member serves a three-year term and meets once a month. Some responsibilities are protecting groundwater from contamination, protecting private and public water supplies, ensuring dwellings are fit for human habitation, preventing epidemics and the spread of disease through measures such as vaccinations and quarantine, protecting against environmental hazards, inspecting food establishments, recreational camps and public swimming pools, enforcing DEP regulations on the disposal of wastewater (Title 5), enforcing EPA/DEP regulations on preventing pollution from air, water, solid waste and toxic wastes, enforcing regulations to control noise pollution.
