The minutes of the February 26, 2019 minutes were approved as written.

The preliminary project list was reviewed, and the following changes were noted:

- Bay Road (Route 1A) is under MassDOT jurisdiction, therefore Complete Streets Funding may not be used on these projects. Several projects that the Committee determined to be desirable on the Prioritization Plan are along Bay Road. These projects should remain on the plan, but may be placed in a lower priority so alternate sources of funding may be considered.
- Constructing sidewalk along Essex Street between Forrest Street and School Street is a current DPW project and can be combined with the construction of sidewalk along School Street between Knowlton Street and Essex Street.
- Reconstruction of the existing Linden Street sidewalk is a current DPW project.
- Linden Street / Bay Road intersection project would require coordination with Wenham.
- Bike lanes along Cutler Road should be removed as a project due to the scenic nature of the roadway.
- The Miles River Road / Bridge Street intersection project should maintain the median island.
- Add a one-way bicycle lane loop along Bridge Street to Essex Street to Miles River Road.
- Bridge Street / Sagamore Street intersection project should not include a roundabout.
- Moulton Street may be good candidate for bike lanes, but not sidewalks.
- Add a project at the intersection of Asbury Street and Highland Street.

The Committee decided upon conducting a Public meeting June 11<sup>th</sup> at 7 PM to obtain resident feedback on potential complete streets projects. The Committee's list will be available, but will not be presented as a final list to ensure open discussion from residents on their areas of concern.
