

Chairman Steve Ozahowski called the meeting to order at 5:02 p.m.

The Board of Assessors (BOA) reviewed and approved the February 2, 2022 minutes. Joe Shaktman moved to accept the minutes. Chris Campbell seconded. Vote: Unanimous.

BOA reviewed and signed the motor vehicle excise tax commitment sheets for the Treasurer Collector.

BOA reviewed and signed the February 16, 2022 motor vehicle excise tax rescind.

BOA granted one abatement application and denied another abatement application. The Board also discussed what actions it could take on another application but mentioned that an inspection was necessary.

The BOA tabled a discussion on a Chapter 61A application until Steve Ozahowski can research with other Assessors.

The Board discussed 0 Bridge Street lots and suggested that the property owner could file abatement in January 2023 if he still owns the property.


The Board also mentioned that it would need a measure/lister in the next fiscal year related to the 10-year revaluation.
