Submission Requirements

- A copy of this <u>Appeal of Decision of the Building Inspector</u> form date stamped by the Office of the Town Clerk.
- A <u>Request for Certification of Abutter's List</u> form which may be obtained by completing the attached form and submitting it to the Assessor's Office.
- The Salem News <u>Request for Legal Notice</u> form so the Public Hearing Notice may be published twice in a local newspaper as required by Massachusetts General Law. The Applicant/Property Owner is responsible for the necessary cost of the publications.
- A copy of the written and signed Letter of Denial from the Building Inspector.
- If applicable to the matter of the Appeal: 8 copies of an 18 x 24" or larger Site Plan to a scale of 1" = 40' minimum, by a Massachusetts Registered Architect, Civil Engineer, or Land Surveyor, illustrating the shape and location of the proposed building(s)/construction, the existing site, and the proposed changes to the site with lot size and setbacks of proposed construction and if applicable, the location of wetlands, septic system and well.
- A legible <u>Written Narrative</u> describing the reason(s) for the appeal and the specific point(s) of the disagreement with the Building Inspector's Decision.

If construction or site work was started by the Property Owner it is highly suggested, but not mandatory, that 8 copies of photographs of the current condition of the construction/site should be included. Multiple photos on one page will be acceptable.
