Introductions & Backgrounds

- Paul Vernucci (Regional Shared Services Coordinator): EMS background.
 During COVID, worked for the CDC at a quarantine site, then helped launch a testing and vaccine center at Worcester State.
- **David Smith** (Hamilton Board of Health Chair): Background in public health and environmental health impact regulation.
- Dennis Palazzo (Regional Health Inspector): Former Director of the Hamilton Health Department.
- Barbara McCarthy (Rockport Board of Health Chair): Nursing background, with expertise in infection control, environmental safety, and disaster planning.
- Jessie Palm (Regional Social Worker): 20 years in social work, with a focus on prevention, education, and community health.

- Kate O'Hara (Social Worker Intern): MSW student with experience in nursing homes, interested in preventive and community-based work.
- Ray Cahill (Rockport Health Director): Background in veterinary medicine; recent transition to public health with strong interest in epidemiology and community service.
- Erin Kirchner (Essex BoH Administrator): 20 years in local public health; including EMS
- **Jeff Thomas** (Essex Administrative Clerk): Diverse background in automotive manufacturing, x-ray technology, phlebotomy, and massage therapy.
- Dr. Andrew Ting (Wenham BoH Chair): Background in epidemiology, medicine, healthcare management, and advertising; 15 years on the Board of Health.
- Peter Mirandi (Hamilton Health Director): Extensive experience in emergency preparedness and pandemic response; formerly served in Danvers and Reading.

Nurse Staffing Challenges & Job Description Discussion

- Two hiring rounds for a regional nurse were unsuccessful:
 - One candidate requested part-time, remote work at \$120k/year
 - Another candidate (based in Warwick, RI) was unfamiliar with location of Rockport
- Job description is being reworked with committee input and HR support
- Other towns have shifted toward hiring epidemiologists due to nurse shortages
- New proposed title: Regional Public Health Liaison

Suggestions

- Soften supervisory language in job description to promote collaboration with local RNs
- Emphasize flexibility (scheduling, part-time options, etc.)
- Consider a broader clinical background (e.g., MPH, microbiology, epidemiology)
- Highlight public health vs. clinical/hospital nursing roles to attract betteraligned applicants

Key Role Functions Identified

Vaccination clinics

- MAVEN case investigation and backup
- Infectious disease control
- Emergency preparedness
- Community education (e.g., mental health, nutrition, maternal support)
- Program development and collaboration

Job Design Recommendations

- Full-time role supported to ensure presence in all four towns
- Openness to candidates from a range of clinical/public health backgrounds
- Broader advertising: local colleges, MPH programs, LinkedIn, public health coalitions

Regional Inspector Discussion

- Rockport's short-term rental inspection bylaw will significantly increase inspection needs
- Suggestion to develop a regional response model and standardize:
 - Tobacco regulations
 - Septic inspections
 - Fee structures
- Mention of mutual aid agreements as a helpful solution for interim support
- Paul encouraged the use of the shared Google form for regional service requests
- Feedback on customizing the form is welcome

Regional Social Worker Update

- Jessie announced Youth Mental Health First Aid trainings in May hosted by Gloucester Prevention Network
- Free 8-hour trainings for adults who work with youth (parents, teachers, coaches, public safety staff)
- Certification provided; trainings scheduled in Essex, Rockport, Manchester, and other towns
