

Tree Removal Application

Approval is required from the Hamilton Conservation Commission before any work is conducted within protection wetland resource areas. Work includes removal or trimming of trees, brush, vegetation; lawn expansion; soil grading, and construction. Wetland resource areas include the 100-foot buffer to a wetland, pond, vernal pool, stream and 200-feet from a river, and areas under conservation restrictions.

Tree/vegetation removal plan

Include relevant information: 1) identification/site plan of wetland resource area and relationship to tree/vegetation to be removed; 2) number of trees/shrubs; size of trees (less than 25 feet, 25-50 feet, over 50 feet), 3) description of any other alterations in wetland resource area: type of vegetation to be removed and area of impact.

Tree Hazard Description

Include an arborist report and/or other documentation to explain why trees need to be removed/pruned.

Tree Replacement/Mitigation for Loss of Vegetation

Provide information including an illustration or plan to show how loss of trees/vegetation will be avoided and minimized. (Attached is a suggested list of wetland trees and vegetation and nearby sources for replanting materials.)
