COURSE CANCELLATION

Classes that do not attain the minimum enrollment will be cancelled 48 hours prior to the scheduled start date. If cancelled you will receive a full refund. We reserve the right to reschedule or change classes. You will be contacted via email if your class is cancelled, otherwise, plan on attending.

COURSE CONFIRMATION

We DO NOT provide confirmations for program registrations. If a class is filled you will be placed on the waiting list. If a spot opens you will be contacted via phone. Otherwise, plan on attending.

MAKE UP CLASSES

All attempts will be made to reschedule classes that have been cancelled due to inclement weather or instructor absence. We are not responsible for making up classes that are missed due to the participants inability to attend.

INCLEMENT WEATHER

All classes will run unless you are otherwise notified. In the event that we need to cancel programming/event an email and a text alert will be sent to class participants. In the event of a last minute cancellation participants will be contacted via phone. It will also be posted on our website at www.hwrecreation.com.

FILLED CLASSES

You are urged to register as soon as possible. Classes are filled on a first come first served basis. We do not “hold” spots. If your class is filled, you will be placed on a waiting list.

LOW ENROLLMENT CLASSES

You are urged to register as soon as possible. Our vendors have a minimum enrollment number that must be met at least 1 week prior to the start of a class. This number varies depending on the vendor and the nature of the class.
